REVIEW OF THE WEEK

There were twists and turns by the day at the top of the Premier Division in midweek with BRADFORD PARK AVENUE dropping two valuable points at home on Monday in a goalless stalemate with BUXTON only for GUISELEY to go one worse a day later when MATLOCK TOWN substitute Ross Hannah came on to score both goals against the Nethermoor side who lost 2-1. These results were just the fillip BOSTON UNITED needed when they went in to action on Wednesday and they made no mistake at WORKSOP TOWN where they won 5-1 to go top on goal difference albeit having played a game more than their two rivals. Things continued to move Boston's way on Saturday when they beat FC UNITED of MANCHESTER 4-1 in front of the Premier Division's biggest crowd of the season of over 2,500 whilst GUISELEY lost at home to MARINE when they failed to score for only the second time this season. BRADFORD PARK AVENUE, meanwhile were grateful for a stoppage time penalty to salvage a point at FRICKLEY ATHLETIC to leave Boston the favourites to grab the title next Saturday if they can win at MARINE. Grabbing one of the remaining play places with two single goal wins were NORTH FERRIBY UNITED with the remaining spot being between KENDAL TOWN and RETFORD UNITED who met on Saturday with Kendal winning 2-1.

It was a huge week for FC HALIFAX TOWN in the First Division North for having vanquished nearest challengers LANCASTER CITY 4-0 last Saturday they travelled to CURZON ASHTON on Monday and banged in another five without reply. They then came up with the bonus ball when Lancaster were beaten 2-0 by mid table TRAFFORD and given this encouragement Halifax beat RADCLIFFE BOROUGH 2-1 on Thursday as they moved to within touching distance of the title. They were in goalscoring mood again on Saturday when they beat next to bottom OSSETT ALBION 4-2 and with LANCASTER CITY failing to register a maximum haul at home to COLWYN BAY in a 1-1 draw Halifax now not only have one hand on the trophy but four fingers of the other as well as they have a better goal difference of 22. They now need a point from two home games to be 100% certain. COLWYN BAY came from behind at home to MOSSLEY on Tuesday to win 3-1 and secure their play-off place but the other two places looked less certain with SKELMERSDALE UNITED joining Curzon in being beaten at home in midweek when they lost to WAKEFIELD. Curzon, however, at least bounced back on Thursday to pick up three points at MOSSLEY and followed up with five goals at home at Saturday to clinch their play-off spot. Skem also returned to goal form at the weekend with five against MOSSLEY whilst LEIGH GENESIS were falling further behind with a draw at WOODLEY SPORTS. Skem now need three points from as many games to be absolutely sure of making the play-offs although manager Tommy Lawton will not be looking forward to that scenario as quite simply he doesn't do the play-off thing having lost three of them since their introduction.

In the First Division South CHASETOWN merely put off the inevitable when they beat MICKLEOVER SPORTS to temporarily halt the Derbyshire club's march to the title in midweek but the win only served to delay things for four days with Mickleover winning at QUORN on Saturday to lift the championship in their first season. Chasetown's consolation, however, is that they are at least assured of a play-off spot as are GLAPWELL after two wins in the week and KIDSGROVE ATHLETIC who, after dropping two points in midweek, recovered to land all three on Saturday. SHEFFIELD FC were another side to enjoy two wins and they look like taking the final play off slot after both BELPER TOWN and WITTON ALBION blew their chances with defeats on their travels. The only side now able to catch Sheffield are LEEK TOWN but matters are firmly in Sheffield's own hands. Elsewhere SPALDING UNITED left it to their very last away game of the season to register their first win on the road thanks to a Luke Forbes goal at CAMMELL LAIRD.

The first domestic silverware of the campaign was won on Wednesday evening when BELPER TOWN lifted the President's Cup beating STAMFORD 3-1. Both sides cancelled one another out with a goal apiece very early in each period and extra-time was looming large when Belper scored twice in the last five minutes to clinch the first part of an attempted cup double as they take on MATLOCK TOWN in the Derbyshire Senior Cup Final at Pride Park next Tuesday.
